Professional Certificate in Digital Education

Introduction

This course reflects the roles of individuals who apply strong specialised skills and knowledge in the field of education and capability development using digital platforms and resources. In these functions, they make high-level, independent judgements in significant planning, design, operational and educational outcomes within highly varied and contexts. The qualification aims to enhance, but not replace, a teaching or training qualification. As may be seen below, it may apply to a range of job roles. The course as scheduled can be completed in 6-12 months. Learners can negotiate completion of assessable work in a longer time frame

Corporate or Group Options

Any part of this course can be packaged for Corporate or Group Settings, Each Topic equates to between ½ to 1 day in a workshop setting. Flexible delivery options are available, including Webinar based delivery.

Delivery Method

This course is delivered using the Learning Utility framework developed by Presenter Dr. Mark Keough. Learners join a Community of Practice based on the web site Progressing Digital Education. Through this community learners will contribute ideas, concepts, conversation as well as evidence of learning. The community contains a rich number of learning resources relating to the course including a Learning Guide based on a linear completion of the course over a 6-12 month period and live and archived webinars for each unit as per the guide. Learners are encouraged to participate in the manner that suits them however, and prioritizing participation in line with work related projects is encouraged.

Post Course Alumni

Learners may maintain their participation in the community of practice as alumni supported by Meechi Road Consulting through the Progressing Digital Education website. This would involve a small annual subscription fee.
